What's new in Registry 2.0?

- **Launches May 15, 2026** — Registry unavailable May 8–14 (see timeline)
- New certificates for Certified Crude Oil and CO₂ data
- CIRIS support for cross-region certificate export (e.g. LNG to Europe)
- Streamlined workflows — no more Drafts, faster submissions
- **Action required:** submit or execute all Draft items by May 7



New features in Registry 2.0

New features have been added, including:

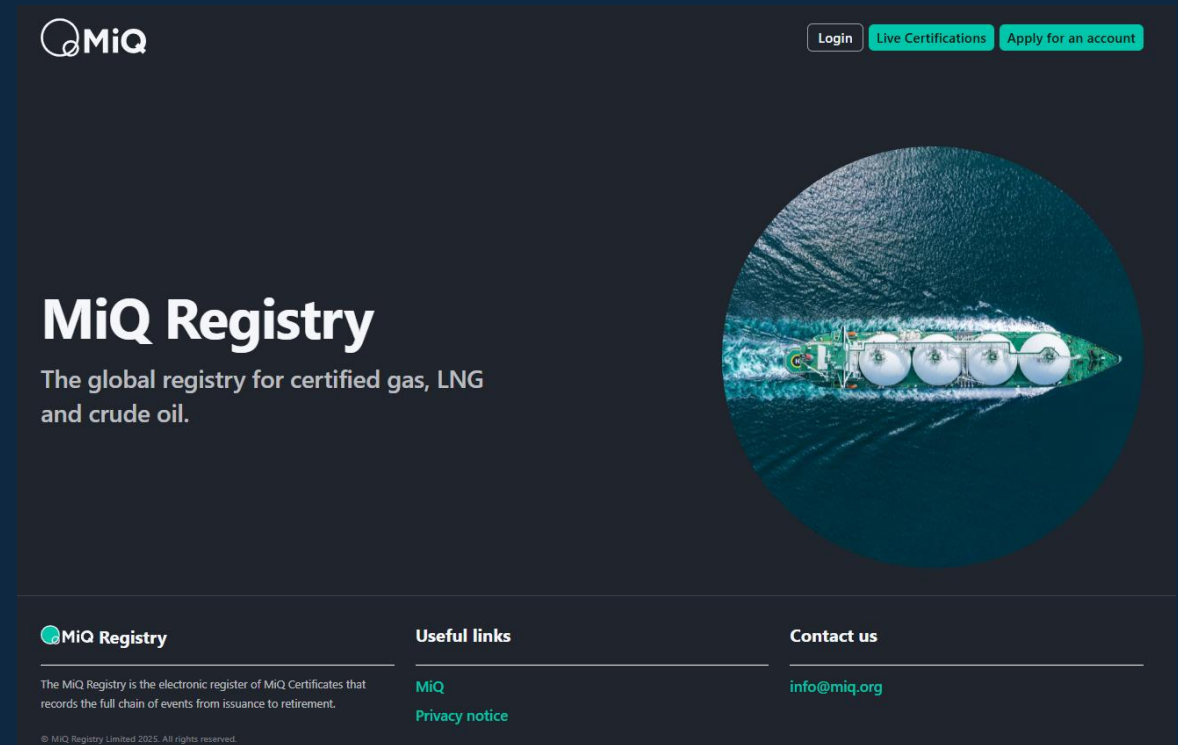
- Certificates for **Certified Crude Oil** (in addition to Certified Natural Gas)
- Additional certificate attributes for **CO₂** and **CO_{2e}**

Streamlined user experience:

- Removal of 'drafts' so you can submit or transact immediately
- Improved email notifications on receipt of transfers and on submission / approval of facility-related data
- Facility reporting is embedded in the Registry

Coming soon:

- **Certificate export** to other regions (such as LNG to Europe)

* We will launch Registry 2.0 as early as possible during the week of May 11–15. We will inform users as soon as Registry 2.0 is available.

What you need to know before launch

Password reset

- You'll still log in with the same email address
- On launch you'll be asked to set a new password — a reset link will arrive by email
- If the link expires, request a new one from the login page

⚠ Action required: check your Drafts now

- Draft items on the current Registry will **not carry over** to Registry 2.0
- Please submit or execute all items in Draft **before 8 May** — more detail on the following slides
- We'll notify you when Registry 2.0 is live

Key dates: Registry goes offline **May 8** | Registry 2.0 launches **May 15** | Facility operators: submit issue requests by **May 1**

Account holders: new capabilities

New features have been added, including

- You'll now be able to hold, transfer and retire certificates for **Certified Crude Oil** in addition to Certified Natural Gas
- You'll see additional certificate attributes for CO₂ and CO_{2e}
- You'll be able to move certificates between regions using CIRIS, which facilitates the export of certificates to Europe to support compliance with the EU Methane Regulations, for example

Certificate Regions

- We've added many more Certificate Regions. We've also split the North America region into separate countries (e.g., USA, Canada)
- All existing retirements will still be tagged with North America but please check your beneficiaries' locations when making a new retirement.

Coming soon: Certificate export to Europe via CIRIS — supporting compliance with **EU Methane Regulations**

Account holders: new capabilities and actions required

Streamlined user experience

- **Removal of 'drafts'** so you can create and execute transfers and retirements straight away
- **Email notifications** on receipt of transfers

Certificate Expiry

- **Certificates with Issue Months older than 3 years will be expired each month.**

Important – we've removed Draft and Pending transfers and retirements

- This means that any transfers and retirements that are in your **Draft or Pending tables** on the current Registry will no longer be available in Registry 2.0.
- Please check and ensure you've either executed items in **Draft** and **Pending** or are happy for them to be removed. Your certificates are safe — you'll just need to recreate any unexecuted transfers or retirements in Registry 2.0.

⚠ Action required: Execute any Draft and Pending transfers and retirements you want transacted by **May 7**

Facility operators: new capabilities and actions required

Streamlined user experience:

- Removal of Drafts and Pending tables. You'll see all facilities, for example, in a single table; and you'll be able to create and submit audits and issue requests in one step.
- Automated email notifications to confirm submission and approval
- Non-compliance event reporting (renamed 'Reportable Events') is now on the Registry, so no more emailing spreadsheets for these events.
- You can now add and update your default accounts for your facilities.

Important – we've removed Draft facilities, audits and issue requests

- Any facilities, audits or issue requests that are in **Draft** on the current Registry will be removed.
- Ensure that you've submitted everything that's in **Draft** (e.g. draft issue requests). You won't lose any certificates, but the Draft request will be removed in the update.

⚠ Action required: Check your drafts
Submit issue requests that you need approved in short order before **May 1**

How do I reset my password after launch?

- Go to <https://www.miqregistry.org/login> and click **Forgot?** — a reset link will be emailed to you

Will my existing certificates and data be preserved?

- Yes — all issued, transferred and retired certificates are preserved.
- Only **Draft and Pending** transfers and retirements will not carry over

When exactly will Registry 2.0 be available?

- We aim to launch as early as possible during the week of May 11–15. We will email users as soon as it is live
