MiQ Fee List

Scope

This MiQ Fee List sets out the fees payable for:

- access to the MiQ Registry by users;
- the Issuance and Retirement of MiQ Certificates;
- the Issuance and Retirement of combined MiQ & EO100™ Certificates.

MiQ Registry users

Users that access the MiQ Registry include:

- **Registrants** are typically producers and operators of Facilities that produce, process and transport natural gas for Certification. Registrants maintain a Facility's registered information and provide the information required for MiQ Certificates to be issued;
- **Account Holders** are typically buyers and sellers of MiQ Certificates. Account Holders hold Accounts at the MiQ Registry for the holding, transfer and Retirement of Certificates; and
- **Certification Bodies** that audit Facilities and enter, amend and approve information relating to Audit Reports for Facilities.

Part 1 – Fees for access to the MiQ Registry

Annual Registry Account Fee

Registrants	US\$ 1,500
Account Holders	US\$ 1,250
Certification Bodies	US\$ 0

Invoiced by the MiQ Issuing Body on account opening and annually thereafter.

Note: There are currently no fees payable by Certification Bodies for access to the MiQ Registry.

Part 2 – Fees for MiQ Certificates

Registrant fees

To participate in the MiQ Program, Facilities that produce natural gas must be registered with the Issuing Body by a Registrant. A Registrant can register multiple Facilities.

Fees quoted are per Facility and depend on a Facility's production capacity*.

* Fees do not include the costs of independent third-party Certification Body assessments, which may vary based upon location, size and complexity of the assessment. These costs will have to be agreed separately between the Registrant of the Facility and the its preferred Certification Body

Account Holder fees

Retirement Fee

US cents 0.025 per MMBtu

(equivalent to US cents 0.085 per MWh)

Invoiced monthly by the MiQ Registry Operator. Subject to a minimum of US\$ 750 per Retirement.



Part 3 – Fees for combined MiQ & EO100™ Certificates

Under combined MiQ & EO100™ certification, a single Certificate will be issued under both standards for each MMBtu of gas.

Registrant fees

One-time EO Registration Fee **US\$ 10,000**
 (For EO self-assessment tool, review and preparation process)
Invoiced separately by EO on registration of the operator of the Facility with Equitable Origin.

Fees for Facilities that produce natural gas

To participate in the MiQ Program, Facilities that produce natural gas must be registered with the Issuing Body by a Registrant. Fees depend on a Facility’s production capacity,**.*

** Possible scope differences between the Equitable Origin Site definition and MiQ Facility definition exist. The Annual EO100™ Certification Fee is charged on the basis of the Equitable Origin Site definition. The other fees are based upon the MiQ Facility definition.*

*** Fees do not include the costs of independent third-party assessments, which may vary based upon location, size and complexity of the assessment.*

Account Holder fees

MiQ + EO100™ Retirement Fee **US cents 0.050 per MMBtu**
 (equivalent to US cents 0.170 per MWh)
Invoiced monthly by the Registry Operator. Subject to a minimum of US\$ 1,500 per retirement.
